Raw deal

- Bondi Junction retailer fined for selling unpasteurised milk
- Alternative health advocates rally in support

FOR Peter Melov, of Bondi Junction, selling raw milk was a reflection of his generous nature, not a business proposition, but he now recognises it has cost him dearly.

Raw milk is not homogenised or pasteurised, it comes straight from the cow and therefore is unprocessed. It is sometimes sold as Cleopatra's milk for bathing.

It is illegal to sell the milk for human consumption in NSW, but advocates argue it is more easily digested because its enzymes are not destroyed. Mr Melov was part of Global Sov, an organisation which sold raw milk and
